



MEET THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

GARY ADAMS

(EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR)

Gary served as a full-time youth pastor for 34 years in Southern California, Dallas, Texas, and in Southern Idaho, before transitioning into full-time camping ministry. He has been involved with Christian camping since first attending in 1971, 50 years ago. Over the years, Gary has done it all! Since being a camper up from 4th grade through college aged, kitchen help/cook, recreation leader, counselor, speaker, director for many years of Jr. High and High School camps, board member and executive board member, and most recently as the Executive Director at Skyview Ranch Christian (SVR) Camp and Retreat Center in Ohio. Skyview employed 18 staff, was located on 175 acres, and served 9,000 guests annually year round. Due to a massive fire and Covid-19, the staff was dissolved, and SVR wasn't able to do camp in 2020.



MEET THE STAFF

We are excited to share that BCC has hired three new full-time positions on staff. Who are they? What are they doing? What are their roles? (See below)



After camp's shutdown last year the camp board decided that a restart of camp was in order, and that a brand new team was needed to head it up. The first hire was **GARY ADAMS** who started February 1, 2021 as camp's new *Executive Director*. Gary came to camp with 30+ years experience as a pastor along with a number of years experience directing camps. Camp is in his DNA, so he will be overseeing all of BCC's operations as well as coordinating with outside guest groups.



Camp's second hire was **CALEB HAMILTON** who started February 15, 2021 as *Church Relations Coordinator*. Caleb grew up coming to BCC his entire life, and was called by God to be a pastor at camp. Caleb has 10 years of experience as a children/youth pastor and will be directing Kids, Jr. High, and High School camps this summer.



The final hire for BCC was **COREY HULL** who started March 1, 2021 as *Assistant Director*. Corey comes to BCC with a wide spectrum of experience in ministry and has a heart to love people well. Combined with his passion and experience for horses, Corey was the obvious choice for the role. He will be spearheading camp's horse program, and assisting Gary as needed.

THE RESTART OF CAMP

If you've ever been a part of a restart of anything you know it's A LOT of work, and our team has been hard at work to get things ready for summer.

BCC's new team hit the ground running March 5th this spring. The amount of work that was needed to bring camp back online digitally as well as physically was huge. Gary quickly went to work contacting all the past guest groups and cleaning up camp's main offices. Caleb immediately started working on camp's website and networking with churches, donors, and other past camp affiliates to talk about summer camps. Corey got right to

work tackling a variety of physical projects on camp property and started working with camp's herd to start profiling each horse. Gary and Corey's wives Leesa (Adams) and Breanna (Hull) went through camp's main office building cleaning and organizing. The team is aware of the amount of work ahead of them and are determined.



RESTARTING A CAMP



The **RESTART** team for Beartooth Christian Camp (BCC) is only made up of three paid staff and their families. After the shutdown in 2020, the entire staff at BCC was let go. Before Gary Adams and Corey Hull came to BCC they underwent a very similar situation at the camp they were ministering at. Looking for jobs, praying hard for God's leading, the two along with their families were led to BCC.

Caleb Hamilton was feeling God's tug on his heart to help camp, but didn't know what that looked like until he heard about the "Church Relations Coordinator" position, or as he likes to think of it as camp's "Hype Guy." 
